Genuine Unity Acts 1:11-14

I. The Earliest Gathering of the Post-resurrection Church

a. They obeyed Jesus' command 1:4 cf. Lk 24:49

Returned to their meeting (lodging?) place in Jerusalem

- b. The identified company
 - i. The Eleven

Lists of the 12: Lk 6:14ff; Mt 10:2ff; Mk 3:16ff Noteworthy variations (see Jn 14:22)

ii. The Women (including Mary, Jesus' mother)

With Jesus in his travels Lk 8:2-3

At the crucifixion Jn 19:25; Mk 15:40

At the tomb Jn 20:1, 11-18

iii. Jesus' brothers (younger children of Mary & Joseph)

Infrequently mentioned in the Gospels

Mt 12:46ff; 13:55; Mk 3:31ff; Jn 2:12; 7:3, 5

Mentioned twice by St. Paul

I Cor 9:5; Gal 1:19

Converted after the resurrection

As Acts 1:14 makes clear (cf. Gal 1:19)

- c. Their activity
 - i. Praising God in the Temple Lk 24:53
 - ii. United in prayer and supplication v. 14 *cf.* 2:42-47

II. True human unity results from the New Covenant community

- a. False unity
 - i. Racial or socio-economic
 - ii. Political
 - iii. Familial
 - iv. Blurring the sexes
 - v. Common speech
 - vi. Unified opinions
- b. True unity
 - i. Cannot be enforced by human government
 - ii. Is only a result of incorporation into the Body of Christ I Cor 12:12-13; *See* Mt 12:46ff
