“God Exalts His People”
Exodus 11:1-3

- I.** Pharaoh shall drive Israel from the land v.1
 - A.** Predicted 3:20; 6:1
“I will stretch out my hand and strike Egypt”
 - B.** The reminder 11:1
“I will bring one more blow upon Pharaoh”
 - C.** Fulfilled 12:31-33, 39
“They were thrust out of Egypt” (*cf.* Ps 105:38)

- II.** The spoiling of Egypt vv. 2-3a
 - A.** Predicted 3:21-22
“You shall not go out empty”
 - B.** The reminder 11:2-3a
“The Lord gave the people favor” (Ps 105:36-38)
 - C.** Fulfilled 12:35-36
“And they spoiled the Egyptians” (*cf.* Prov 13:22)

- III.** The greatness of Moses v. 3b
 - A.** Very great in the land of Egypt
The Egyptian populace – they wanted him gone
 - B.** Very great in the sight of Pharaoh’s servants
See 9:20, 34; 10:7; *contra* 9:20
 - C.** Very great in the sight of the people
The children of Israel (*cf.* 3:12) – they followed him out

Humility is the path to greatness
Numb 12:3 (*cf.* Ps 147:6; 37:11; Mt 5:5)
Lk 14:7-11; Jas 4:10
